| <ul style="list-style-type: none">to allow creation of journal only on recurrences which don't cause new issue creation. This may e.g. allow for creating better email notification experience. When you have email notifications set to inform about new issues, you may not need to have 2nd one for journal entry addition on base issue in 'copy issue' or 'copy last recurrence of issue' modes. On the other hand 'in-place' mode does not create new issue. So to trigger email notification on new recurrence you may want to have journal entry added on it. | |
